


Iowa



Spring: (March-June) Snow begins to melt. Early flowers start to bloom.

Summer: (June-Sept) Days are hot, and nights are cool. Many plants are growing.

Fall: (Sept-Dec) Crops start to get ready for harvest. Tree leaves and grasses change color.

Winter: (Dec-Mar) Snow begins to fall and cover the ground. All plants are dormant.

Crops that are <u>perennials</u> start to grow in the spring. Crops are harvested in the fall. Perennials that can live in extreme cold do well in lowa.
