Engage grades K-5 lowa students in the science and social studies of producing pizza ingredients!

Use curated <u>lesson plans and resources</u> to teach the concepts necessary to complete the project. Final projects may be entered in the <u>PizzaThon competition</u> for a chance to win a prize for the class!





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CONTEST RULES:

All students and classrooms in grades K-5 in Iowa are welcome to participate. Students in grades K-2 will be judged separately from 3-5. Students can work individually, in groups, or as a whole class to create presentations that meet the following requirements:

- Yearly theme challenge: MyPlate Pizza
 - Students are challenged to design a pizza focusing on the food groups to be part of a balanced diet
- End artifact may be a poster, slideshow presentation, video, or podcast
- Information should be accurate and show evidence of learning
- Projects should be original (not a pre-existing pizza) and represent the theme
- Projects should be eye-catching and visually appealing

PRIZES:

- 1st place:
 - A pizza party for the class
 - Printed certificate
- 2nd and 3rd place:
 - Printed certificate
